DEL F (Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française) and DAL F (Diplôme Approfondi de Langue Française) are official qualifications awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify the competency of candidates from outside France in the French language. DEL F and DAL F are composed of 6 independent diplomas that correspond to the levels of the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages*.

LEVEL TEST, CERTIFICATES, VALIDATION, ASSESSMENT

On the morning of arrival, students sit a **level test** which allows us to estimate their knowledge, to specify their objectives and to place them in a group corresponding to their level.

At the end of the course, they receive a **certificate of attendance** and a **certificate of proficiency** in French. It is co-signed by CAVILAM and the Blaise Pascal University of Clermont-Ferrand.

We strongly advise participants to validate their knowledge by taking one **official French examination or test** (DELFS, DALF, TCF, TEF)

At the end of their course, we ask students to complete a questionnaire on the quality of the teaching and the stay in Vichy.

ENROLMENT To enrol, you must:

- be at least 16 years old by the first day of the course (Junior course programmes: 12 years old).
- return the completed enrolment form together with the course and enrolment payment and a passport-sized photo (printed or scanned).

CAVILAM declines all responsibility for students aged between 16 and 18. Parents must fill in and send back the parental authorisation and are recommended to take out a special insurance policy for their children's stay in France. Accommodation for these students will be in host-families only (except for Sports & Language programmes).

CONFIRMATION Confirmation of your enrolment, as well as the details of your accommodation will be sent by return post.

METHODS OF PAYMENT Course and enrolment fees are payable in advance. They must be settled by the first day of the course at the latest. Long-term intensive courses (12, 24 and 36 weeks) are due in full on registration.
